Planning Board Report

Chairman of the Planning Board Bill Brown reported that the PB had a relatively short agenda. The first item presented was by Scott Waite who is renovating what used to be known as the Gull Bay Casino. The second topic Chairman Brown addressed is an ongoing believed violation in Black Point. Chairman Brown expressed disappointment in the Lake George Park Commission (LGPC) and Adirondack Park

Agency (APA) and their lack of enforcement in some situations, while others are fined. Chairman Brown reviewed a spread sheet of the Planning Board's activities for 2023. (See attached)
